

Meeting Minutes

February 24, 2020

The Mayor and Board of Commissioners of the City of Sweetwater met in their regular monthly workshop on Monday, February 24, 2020 at 5 p.m. Mayor Lowe opened the workshop with Commissioners present being: Commissioners Hughes, Moser, Richeson, West, and Stockton. City Attorney John Cleveland was present.

In workshop discussion, the county reappraisal requested the city pay a portion of the cost totaling \$8,227. The item was added to the budget amendment ordinance for the March meeting agenda.

Mayor Lowe reviewed the February meeting agenda. The tabled item to review the schedule of fees will be scheduled for the April meeting for discussion. The Capital Improvement Plan was reviewed and the board was advised they must pass it by the April meeting. Several options on the purchase for the fire truck were reviewed from proposals included in the packets. Commissioner West noted the TDOT contract and consultant selection policy on the agenda for March were for the next Surface Transportation Project funds for Linwood and Hawkins Road. He noted this was the first time STP funds were used near a neighborhood and this was the last remaining streets eligible for STP fund use on the city's approved map. City Planner Chuck Whited reviewed the upcoming annexation resolution, plan of services for the annexation, zoning ordinance, and proposed zoning map update. City Recorder Jessica Morgan reviewed a proposed ordinance to amend the budget to formerly adopt the entire budget for the Sweetwater Board of Education including the federal funds.

No action was taken.

The workshop was adjourned at 5:45 p.m.
